Amended guidelines for SDI scheme based on the decisions taken in the meeting of the Apex Committee held on 07-09-2015.


Based on the decisions taken during the meeting of the Apex Committee for the scheme held on 07-09-2015 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE), the guidelines related to Skill Development Initiative Scheme (SDIS) stand further amended as indicated below:

1. The Govt. ITI/ Private ITI will be allowed to run MES modules under SDI scheme other than the trade being run in their premises during regular working hours provided it does not hamper regular training under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) and subject to the following conditions:
 - (i) Govt. ITI/ Private ITI will apply online on SDI portal.
 - (ii) State/UT Govt. will inspect the training facilities as prescribed in the syllabus of each MES course module before allowing such Govt. ITI/ Private ITI to run courses other than being run by them in their premises during regular working hours.
 - (iii) The Govt. ITI/ Private ITI will give undertaking to the State/UT Govt. stating that students undergoing training CTS would not be registered under SDI scheme.
 - (iv) The Govt. ITI/ Private ITI will install Bio-metric device in its premises to capture the attendance of the trainees.
2. The registered VTP under the scheme will be reimbursed 85% of the training cost as first installment instead of 80% for the batches where 100% candidates are enrolled with Aadhar card.
3. The assessment cost which is being reimbursed by States/UT Govts. to Assessing Bodies for conducting assessment under SDI scheme will now be reimbursed through Central Government for the training starting after 01.04.2015. Following procedure would be adopted for reimbursement of assessment fee:
 - (i) Assessing Bodies will submit portal generated bill along with a copy of duly signed result sheet to respective RDAT.

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- (ii) RDAT will scrutinize the bill within seven days and not later than 15 days and thereafter will submit to DGT, MSDE, New Delhi along with verification certificate duly signed by RDAT for releasing the payment to Assessing Bodies. In case, RDAT does not verify the bills within 15 days, such bills treated as deemed verified and will be processed accordingly by DGT, MSDE for further action.
- (iii) SDI Section, DGT, MSDE will submit the bills to IFD, DGT for concurrence and further to PAO, DGT for making payment to Assessing Bodies through RTGS/NEFT.
