Subject: Engagement of Saksham Yuvas for assistance in implementation of 'National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme' (NAPS).

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

Government of India has launched 'National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme' with a target to provide Apprentice Training to 50 lakh youth by year 2020. Under this scheme, huge work of establishment's registration and engagement of apprentices is required to be taken up in the mission mode.

In order to provide assistance to the staff working for NAPS under Apprenticeship Training Scheme, it has been already decided in the meeting of Principals held on 04.07.2017 to engage Saksham yuvas registered under Saksham Yuvas Scheme of Employment department.


These Saksham Yuvas are available with MA/ MBA/ MCA/ M.Com/ M.Tech/ M.Sc/ M.Pharma qualification in post graduate category and with Science/Engineering/ Commerce qualification in graduate category. As per provisions in the scheme, they are required to work for maximum 100 hrs in a one month and honorarium @ Rs. 60/- per hour will be paid to them by Employment Department after receipt of attendance and satisfactory work report from the employer.

Under NAPS, their services can be utilized for survey & motivation of establishments, assistance to establishments for registration on apprenticeship portal, registration of candidates on portal and portal related online activities under your close supervision. It must be taken care of that no regular office file/written work is to be assigned to them. For deployment of these candidates in ITIs, the demand is required to be sent to District Employment Officer.

In view of this, all Principal Govt. ITIs looking after the implementation of NAPS are directed to initiate action for engaging the Saksham Yuvas in the following numbers:-

- One Saksham Yuva with each official working as JAPO or two Saksham Yuvas per institute, which ever number is higher.
- Group-C Govt. ITIs: up to one Saksham Yuva.

This is for your information and necessary action with the direction to send the action taken report to directorate with in 15 days, positively.
