**Subject: Re-evaluation and re-checking of OMR sheets and descriptive subject of Engineering Drawing from 2<sup>nd</sup> semester onward- regarding clarification.**


You are aware that All India Trade Test (AITT) under CTS is conducted on OMR sheets from February 2015 and Engineering Drawing paper is descriptive from 2<sup>nd</sup> semester onward. State Directorate of Himachal Pradesh has sought clarification for Re-evaluation and re-checking of OMR sheets and descriptive subject of Engineering Drawing, as some candidates of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester AITT have applied for the same who have appeared in August 2014.

In this regard, the following is clarified :-

- (i) Regarding OMR sheets, as the OMR sheets are scanned by computer and there is no scope of error while evaluating. Therefore Re-evaluation of OMR sheets is not permissible. In such cases the students can only check his original OMR sheets available with respective State Directorate.
- (ii) Regarding engineering drawing subject, the already existing procedure referred in Appendix VIII (Trade Test Procedure for the Craftsman Training Scheme under the Aegis of NCVT) of Training manual for Industrial Training Institute and centres under Para 49 for Re-evaluation of answer books of All India Trade Test only for descriptive subjects, may be followed.

You are requested to follow the above clarification for re-evaluation/re-checking of OMR sheets and descriptive subject of Engineering Drawing in AITT under CTS.
